LATE PICK UPS

We are charging a fee for late pick-ups as follows:

- 4:30—4:45 Regular dismissal time (no charge)
- 4:45—5:00 \$10 fee per family
- 5:00—5:15 \$20 fee per family
- 5:15—5:30 \$30 fee per family

All fees must be paid or arrangements made for payment before your child can return to the program. If your child has not been picked up and there has been no contact with people that you have designated, we must notify the proper authorities.
